



Changing AutoCAD versions

Each installation of SSDCP is created for a specific version of AutoCAD. If you upgrade or change to a different version of AutoCAD than what your CD was created for, you will need to purchase an "AutoCAD Version Change Kit" from SSDCP. In some cases the necessary files can be emailed to you, but usually a new CD is mailed to you. The CD will automatically modify your SSDCP program files to work with your newer version of AutoCAD.

**** TURN OFF ANTI-VIRUS SOFTWARE FIRST ****

1. Insert the new SSDCP CD. Windows AutoPlay may or may not start the CD ...
2. **If AutoPlay runs the CD ..** answer NO to the 2 small message boxes that will come up before the SSDCP installation screen. When the SSDCP installation screen opens, choose EXIT. Go to step 4.
3. **If AutoPlay does NOT run the CD,** go to step 4 and open the CD manually
4. Open Windows Explorer (My Computer), right click on the CD, and OPEN the CD.
5. Double click on the SSDCP folder.
6. You should see a file called FeatureInstaller2005.exe.
7. Double click on this file to execute it. This is a very quick process.
8. When complete, open and close the CD drawer. AutoPlay will re-open the SSDCP installation menu. Choose to UNINSTALL your SSDCP programs (**NOT** your SSDCP license).
9. Re-install the SSDCP programs.
10. This will complete the SSDCP install process for your NEW AutoCAD version.

The last step is done inside AutoCAD - unloading the old menu then loading the menu for your new version of AutoCAD.

1. Unloading the OLD menu:
 - * In R14- 2005 type the command MENULOAD, find the old SSDCP menu (ex. SSDCP2004.mnu) and unload it.
 - * In 2006 and higher, type the command CUILOAD, find the old SSDCP cui file (ex. SSDCP2008.cui) and unload it.
2. Loading the NEW menu:
 - * Go to TOOLS>RUN SCRIPT, browse to c:\program files(x86)\SSDCP2011 (only 64 bit computers say 'x86'). Run the MenuLoad script file that reflects YOUR version of AutoCAD (ex. MenuLoad2009.SCR)
